### **Objectives:**

- Drug discovery is a complex process involving multiple and often conflicting objectives as well as multiple potential causes of candidate attrition.
- Quantitative structure–activity relationships (QSAR) has adapted to the multi task concept moving from the perception of single-objective to the multi-objective drug discovery.



- Predictions of potency and the different biological/pharmacokinetic/toxicity end points rely on the construction of local or global QSAR models, web platforms and workflows.
- Step-by-step single-objective optimization considers each property or each model separately.
- Multi-objective optimization is based on overall property scores, desirability functions, and the Pareto concept, permitting to conceive an 'overall QSAR' as a function of the separate models.
- Further challenges for QSAR are how to address the multiple pathways of complex diseases, the targeted therapies for individual population groups, and the treatment of big data.


#### **Topics covered:**

- Processing of molecular data.
- Step by step optimization of each model.
- Evaluation of data set model ability.
- Novel approaches to QSAR modeling.
- Role of QSAR in risk management.
- Regulatory decisions in drug discovery and lead optimization.
- QSAR in toxicity prediction.

#### **Learning outcomes:**

- The increasing use of information technology in the discovery of new molecular entities encourages the use of modern molecular-modeling tools to help teach important concepts of drug design to chemistry and pharmacy undergraduate students.
- Statistical models such as quantitative structure–activity relationships (QSAR) often as its 3D QSAR variant are commonly used in the development and optimization of a leading compound.

- Pharmaceutical products should be handled and stored in such a manner as to prevent contamination, mix-ups and cross-contamination.
- Periodic stock reconciliation should be performed by comparing the actual and recorded stocks.
- All significant stock discrepancies should be investigated to check that there have been no inadvertent mix-ups, incorrect issue and/or misappropriation of pharmaceutical products.
